

Leather Backed Needlepoint Belts Measuring Guidelines

BELT SIZE



Belt size is the only measurement we accept for sizing. Feel free to email me with any questions: MarymacNJ@gmail.com Measure carefully corrections are the responsibility of the customer.

Do not use numbers stamped on a belt, pant size or waist size.

STITCHING REQUIREMENTS

Length: Subtract 4-inches from belt size. This is your stitched length.
example: a 36-inch belt requires 32-inches of stitched needlepoint

Approximately 2" of needlepoint on each side will be covered by leather

Width: 2 additional rows TOP and BOTTOM

Folded edge: The folded edge requires stitching 2 additional rows top & bottom. Customarily, the additional rows are stitched using the dominant background color. If no additional rows are stitched, a good portion of the design will be lost, and your final width will be reduced.

Binding Stitch: Another way to finish your needlepoint belt is to use the binding stitch along the top and bottom edge. The addition of the binding stitch replaces the need for fold rows.
